A Reflection

Today we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost and the finale to our beautiful Easter season! After six weeks of Lenten prayer, fasting and charitable works, I hope that your 50 days of Easter joy was a blessed celebration of our Risen Lord! John Foley, SJ, writes, “Pentecost is a feast equal to Christmas and Easter in importance. It is the official sending of the Holy Spirit into men and women.” We tend to treat this feast as merely the end of Easter or even one of those solemnities in the spring with no clear understanding of its worth. I have long desired to see an all-out-celebration on this day!

In the past I have shared the story of the very first time I cantored a Mass, but it bears repeating. It was a Christmas morning Mass and after the sister, who was playing the organ, and I went through everything I was to do, she said to me, “Now sit there and pray to the Holy Spirit to help you.” Of course, my response was, “Yes, sister.” And I did as she said! I have never looked back on that choice. I was convinced that the only reason I didn’t have an epic failure or simply faint face-first on the hard marble was because of those prayers. The Holy Spirit is my go-to in any given situation and I have never been let down!

At one of the St. Mary Mother’s Day Masses, I reflected upon the Holy Spirit in my life as a mother. In the younger years of my children’s lives, asking the Holy Spirit to be with them on school days when they had tough exams or difficult decisions to be

made. In their adult years when they’ve had to make their own way in life and, as their mother, I had to accept that I it was not my job to control and guide their ways. The Holy Spirit has brought me comfort when I ask for protection for them – and trust for me.

As you reflect upon today’s scriptures, keep in mind that the Holy Spirit was not just sent to the disciples. Jesus breathes the Holy Spirit into each of us, empowering us with so many wonderful gifts. It’s not just our joy to use these gifts, it is our responsibility. In our second reading from 1st Corinthians we hear, “To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit.” What gifts have you received from the Holy Spirit? How have you been able to apply them to your daily life? How have you been able to benefit our parish and community with your gifts? Moving forward, what can you do to improve the use of your gifts?

I invite you to take some time this week to reflect upon the Holy Spirit in your life. What might you be called to do differently moving forward? The Spirit ignites us. May the flame of the Holy Spirit be so fierce that you cannot help but spread it throughout all that you do.

Una reflexión

Hoy celebramos la fiesta de Pentecostés y el final de nuestro hermoso tiempo de Pascua. Después de seis semanas de oración cuaresmal, ayuno y obras de caridad, ¡espero que vuestros 50 días de alegría pascual hayan sido una bendita celebración de nuestro Señor Resucitado! John Foley, SJ, escribe: "Pentecostés es una fiesta tan importante como la Navidad y la Pascua. Es el envío oficial del Espíritu Santo a los hombres". Tendemos a tratar esta fiesta simplemente como el final de la Pascua, o incluso como una de esas solemnidades de la primavera sin una comprensión clara de su valor. Llevo mucho tiempo deseando que este día se celebre por todo lo alto.

En el pasado he compartido la historia de la primera vez que canté una Misa, pero vale la pena repetirla. Era una Misa de Navidad por la mañana y después de que la Hermana, que tocaba el órgano, y yo repasáramos todo lo que tenía que hacer, me dijo: "Ahora siéntate ahí y reza al Espíritu Santo para que te ayude". Por supuesto, mi respuesta fue: "Sí, Hermana". E hice lo que ella me dijo. Nunca me he arrepentido de aquella decisión. Estaba convencida de que la única razón por la que no tuve un fracaso épico o simplemente me desmayé de bruces sobre el duro mármol fue por esas oraciones. El Espíritu Santo es mi recurso en cualquier situación y nunca me ha defraudado.

En una de las misas del Día de Santa María, reflexioné sobre el Espíritu Santo en mi vida como

madre. En los primeros años de la vida de mis hijos, le pedí al Espíritu Santo que estuviera con ellos en los días de escuela cuando tenían exámenes difíciles o tenían que tomar decisiones difíciles. En sus años adultos, cuando han tenido que hacer su propio camino en la vida y, como su madre, he tenido que aceptar que no era mi trabajo controlar y guiar sus caminos. El Espíritu Santo me ha traído consuelo cuando pido protección para ellos - y confianza para mí.

Mientras reflexionas sobre las escrituras de hoy, ten en cuenta que el Espíritu Santo no sólo fue enviado a los discípulos. Jesús insufla el Espíritu Santo en cada uno de nosotros, dotándonos de tantos dones maravillosos. No es sólo nuestro gozo usar estos dones, es nuestra responsabilidad. En nuestra segunda lectura de 1ª Corintios oímos: "A cada uno le es dada la manifestación del Espíritu para algún provecho". ¿Qué dones has recibido del Espíritu Santo? ¿Cómo has podido aplicarlos a tu vida diaria? ¿Cómo has podido beneficiar a nuestra parroquia y comunidad con tus dones? De cara al futuro, ¿qué puedes hacer para mejorar el uso de tus dones?

Te invito a que dediques un tiempo esta semana a reflexionar sobre el Espíritu Santo en tu vida. ¿Qué podría llamarte a hacer de manera diferente en el futuro? El Espíritu nos enciende. Que la llama del Espíritu Santo sea tan ardiente que no puedas evitar propagarla en todo lo que haces.

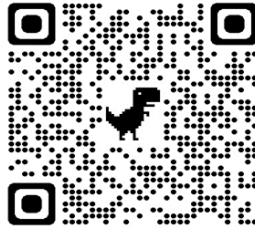

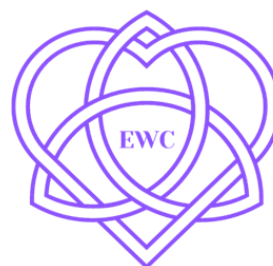
