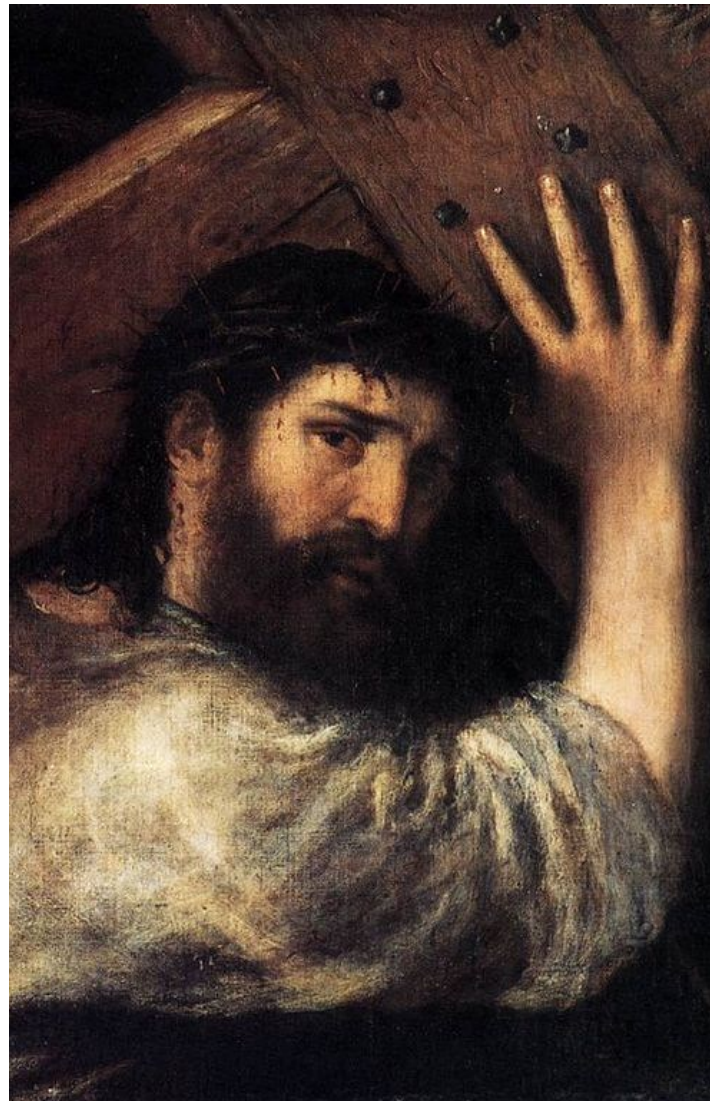

A Reflection

“For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.”

- John 3:17

The Feast of the Holy Cross is a day to meditate on and celebrate the redemption won for us by Christ. I am a fan of the television series *The West Wing*. In one of the episodes, a character comments that the story of her faith, Christianity, ends in death. My sons get a kick out of how angry I get when I start yelling at the TV that it does not end there! The whole point is that Christ passes through death into life and makes the ultimate sacrifice so that we may do the same.

Some people feel it's morbid to wear or raise up a symbol of torture and death with a body on it. For this reason, some will wear or display a cross without a corpus. Yet the cross, called a crucifix when the corpus is on it, is the symbol of our redemption. As Pope Francis has said, “There is no Christianity without the Cross and there's no Cross without Jesus Christ.”

We fly the American flag to display our patriotism on certain days or at special events. We display our fan gear at sporting events or wear the “swag” of our favorite entertainers. These things build community

and express our identity with a way of life or a person we admire. Take time to think about the importance of Jesus Christ in your life. Consider his death and his resurrection, and what they mean to you.

Lift high the cross! Proclaim your love for our Savior and your identity as a member of the Body of Christ. Profess your intent to live life as a Catholic Christian walking in the Way of Christ.

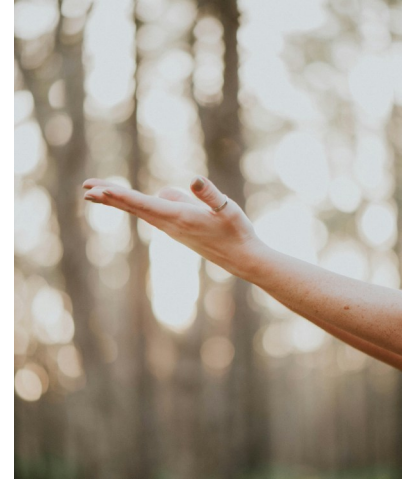

Una reflexión

- Jn 3, 17

La fiesta de la Santa Cruz es un día para meditar y celebrar la redención ganada por Cristo para nosotros. Soy fan de la serie de televisión *El Ala Oeste*. En uno de los episodios, un personaje comenta que la historia de su fe, el cristianismo, termina en la muerte. A mis hijos les hace gracia a lo enfadada que me pongo cuando empiezo a gritarle al televisión que eso no acaba ahí. La cuestión es que Cristo paso de la muerte a la vida y hiso el sacrificio supremo para que nosotros podamos hacer lo mismo.

Algunas personas sienten que es morboso llevar o levantar un símbolo de tortura y muerte con un cuerpo en él. Por esta razón, algunos llevarán o exhibirán una cruz sin cadáver. Sin embargo, la cruz, se llama crucifijo cuando lleva el cuerpo, es el símbolo de nuestra redención. Como ha dicho el Papa Francisco: «No hay cristianismo sin Cruz y no hay Cruz sin Jesucristo.»

Enarbolamos la bandera estadounidense para mostrar nuestro patriotismo en ciertos días o en eventos especiales. Mostramos nuestro

equipamiento de fans en eventos deportivos o llevamos el «swag» de nuestros artistas favoritos. Estas cosas crean comunidad y expresan nuestra identidad con un modo de vida o una persona a la que admiramos. Tóma un tiempo para pensar en la importancia de Jesucristo en tu vida. Piensa en su muerte y su resurrección y en lo que significan para ti.

Levanta la cruz. Proclama tu amor por nuestro Salvador y tu identidad como miembro del Cuerpo de Cristo. Profesa tu intención de vivir la vida como cristiano católico caminando en la senda de Cristo.

Food Insecurity is an issue in our Parish

Many of us shop for groceries without a second thought, but some parishioners must choose between paying bills and buying meals. Families at St. John XXIII increasingly face these tough choices and hunger among seniors in Evanston is also on the rise.

Evanston's Interfaith Action (IAE) and other local food programs are strained as higher costs and reduced federal benefits - such as a 30 percent cut to SNAP - drive greater reliance on local pantries. Funding shortfalls forced IAE to suspend their Produce Mobile program on May 13, 2025.

If you need help providing food for your family we are here to help.

La inseguridad alimentaria es un problema en nuestra parroquia

Muchos de nosotros compramos comida sin pensarlo dos veces, pero algunos feligreses deben elegir entre pagar las cuentas o comprar comida. Las familias de San Juan XXIII se enfrentan cada vez más a estas decisiones difíciles y el hambre entre las personas mayores de Evanston también a aumento.

El programa Interfaith Action de Evanston (IAE) y otros programas locales de comida están bajo una gran presión, ya que el aumento de los costes y la reducción de las prestaciones federales - como el recorte del 30 por ciento del SNAP - hacen que se dependa cada vez más de las despensas locales. La escasez de fondos obligó a IAE a suspender su programa Produce Mobile el 13 de mayo de 2025.
